2012 IECC Energy Codes Have Been Published

The 2012 IECC code books have been published. Here are some quick updates for what to expect in the very near future. But, as we know, the 2009 IECC officially started on April 1, 2011, so it won't be until 2013 that we see the possibility of these new codes. Here's a quick snapshot for the commercial side:

1) The Solar Heat Gain Coefficient for entire window assembly of .25 remains same for climate zone 2 and 3 which represents 90% of Texas and climate zone 4 in the Panhandle remains same at .40.

2) U-factor. **BIG CHANGE.** Metal manufactures get ready because this is going to be a big change, especially for non-thermally broken frame systems. The new u-factor (for entire window system) for climate zone 2 (Houston, San Antonio, Austin, Valley) will be .50. For climate zone 3 (Dallas, Fort Worth, Tyler, Lubbock) .46. We will need to confirm with our metal suppliers if there is any possibility that non-thermally broken frame systems will be able to meet this code. As best I understand whole system u-factors with non-thermally broken systems the best they can achieve is in the .58 to .60 range when an insulated glass unit is used with one lite a double layered silver low emissivity coated glass. As best I see it the only way to get lower than .50 and .46 is with thermally broken metal systems. Amarillo in climate zone 4 will have to be at .38 or lower meaning they will have to use the very best in energy efficient thermally broken frame systems. Entrance doors are allowed higher u-factors but it appears with a .83 requirement for climate zone 2 that all entrance doors will need to be insulated glass with at least one lite a passive / hard coat low e.

3) Maximum area – vertical fenestration area (not including opaque doors and opaque spandrel panels) shall not exceed 30% of the gross above-grade wall area. **This is a major change.** However, an exception allowing up to 40% is permitted if daylight controls are used on each floor and a few other items as well. ***I suggest we all discover what a daylight control is and who installs it and we make these people are very best friends! If you don't then you will have to be happy with 10% less.***

4) Keep in mind that IECC code book always allows one to use ASHRAE code book to comply and as of the 2010 ASHRAE energy code book they have not stipulated that the maximum vertical glazing must be 30%. ASHRAE 2010 energy code book states 40%. But, you will recall ASHRAE proposed the 30% maximum level but due to concerted efforts by many in glass and glazing industry ASHRAE backed down and settled with the 40% that has been standard for many years. However, it seems logical that ASHRAE will push for the 30% maximum compliance for the ASHRAE 2013 energy code book now that the IECC has implemented this new parameter.

Residential Changes:

1) **SHGC moves down to .25.** This is a big change and advances triple silver low e technology for all residential windows.

2) U-factor. Climate zone 2 = .40 and for climate zone 3 and 4 = .35. **This is a major change.** The standard aluminum windows that are non-thermally broken will have extreme difficulty passing code. Even thermally broken metal windows will have difficulties meeting these u-factor requirements. The market for residential windows will shift to vinyl, fiberglass, and wood, and only the very best in thermally broken aluminum window systems will survive.

That's all for now. This code review is now in the hands of Texas A&M Energy Systems Lab and they will take remainder of this year to analyze this new energy code and thus early next year Texas A&M ESL will make their recommendations to SECO (State Energy Conservation Office). Once SECO is finished deliberating and agrees with the findings then the 2012 codes become effective 9 months later.
